June Membership Meeting Change

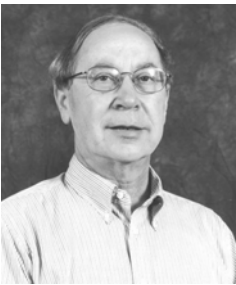

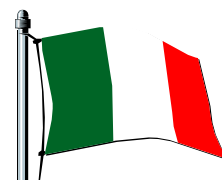
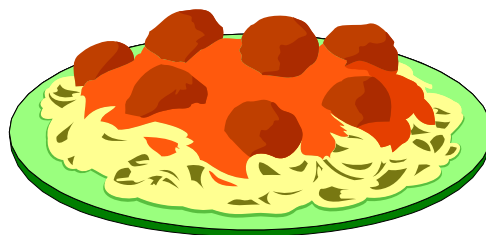
